-  **Company Segment:** Identifies the real-world legal entity for balanced balancing segment accounting.
-  **Cost Center Segment:** Tracks spend by manufacturing department, plant floor, or logistics hub.
-  **Natural Account:** Aligned with Standard/GAAP/IFRS categories for consolidated reporting accuracy.
-  **Product/Line:** Facilitates granular profitability analysis by individual product families or SKU groups.
-  **Future Segment:** Reserved placeholder for foreseeable business expansions or additional dimensions.

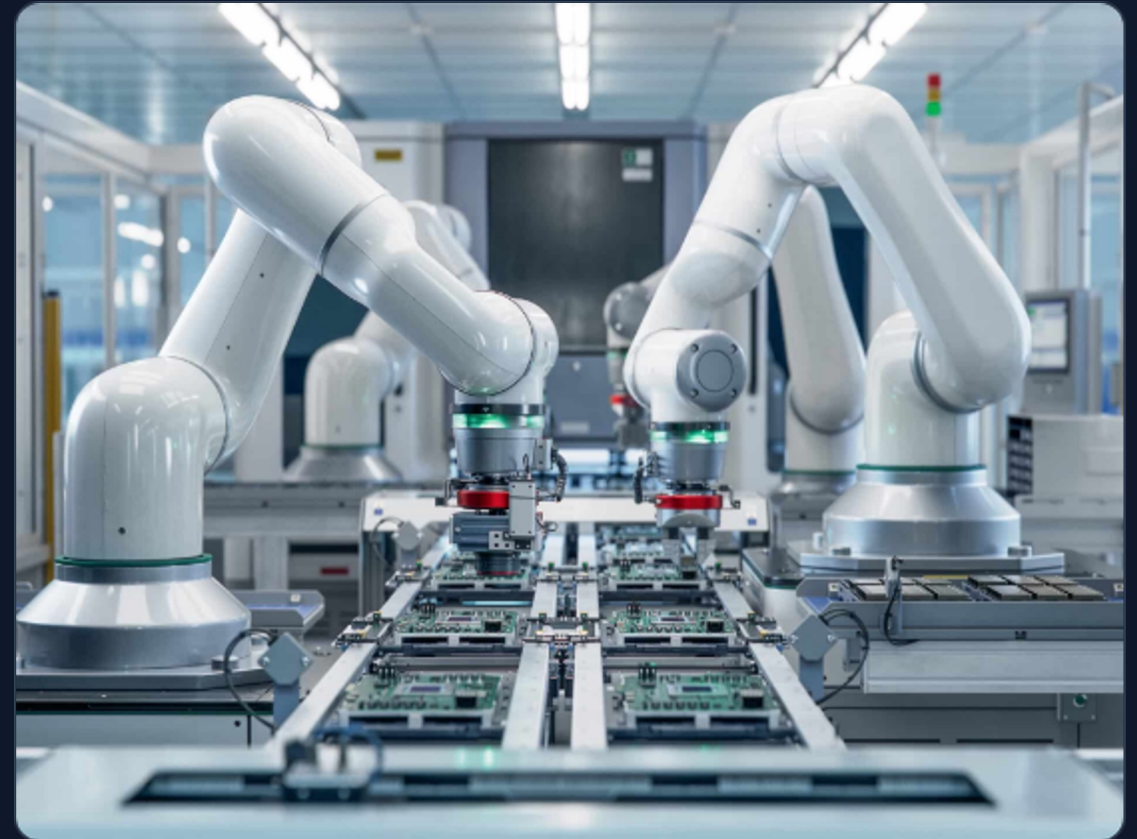

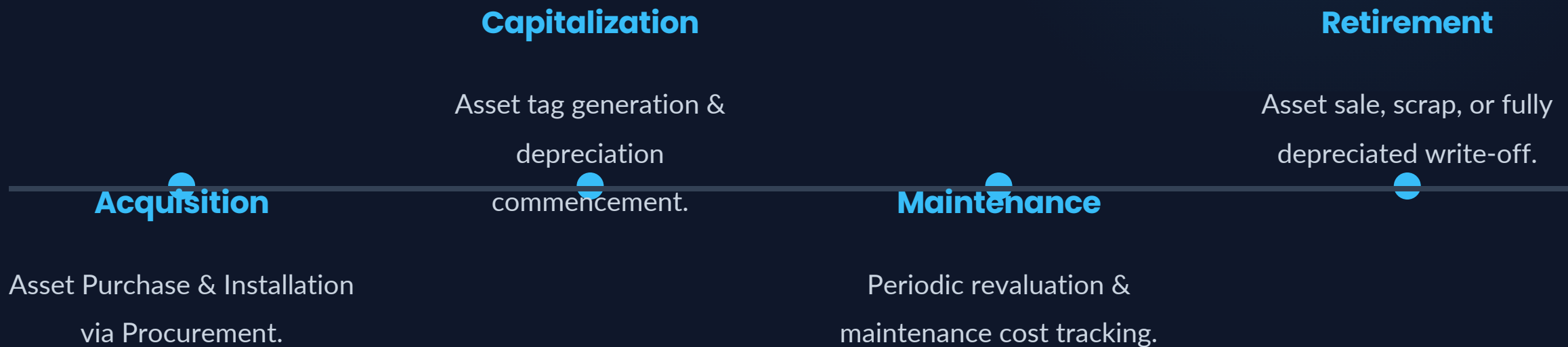

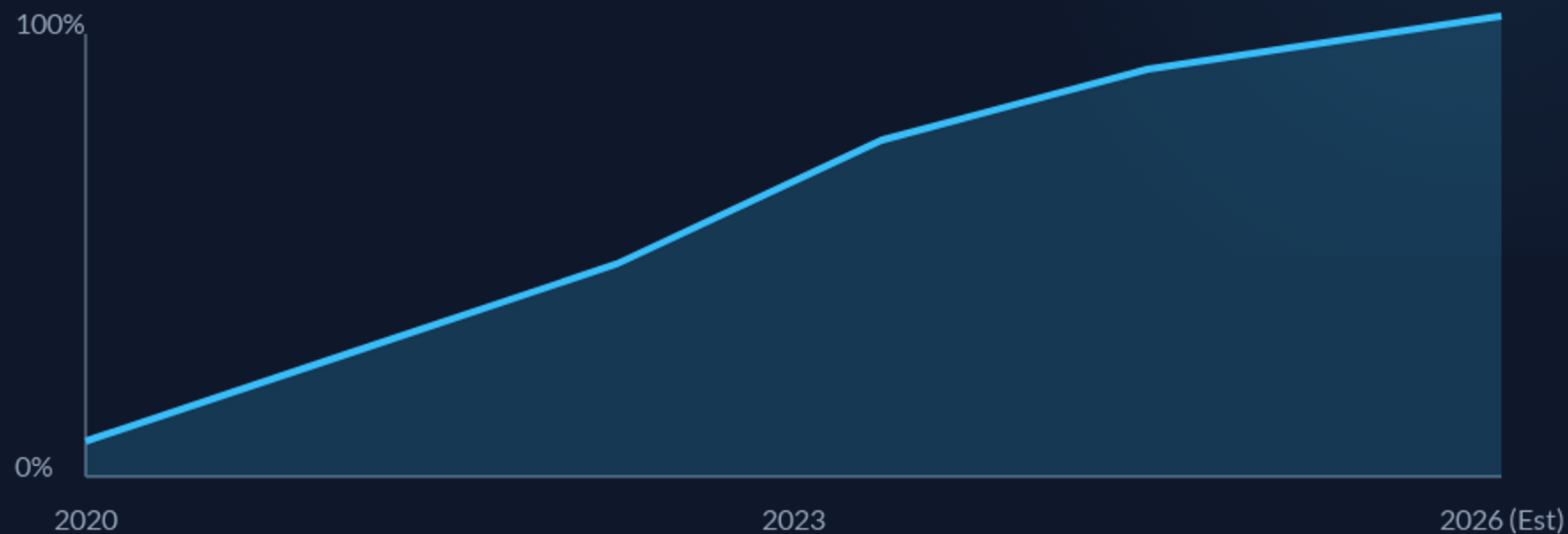
